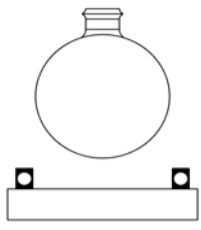


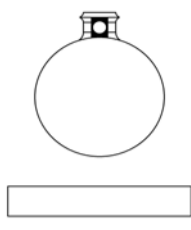
Train headcodes

Maximum speeds shown underneath. Train reporting numbers in brackets.



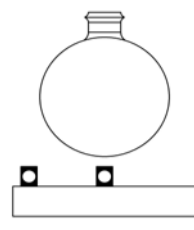
Class A (1)

Express passenger, or a breakdown train or snowplough on it's way to a job.



Class B (2)

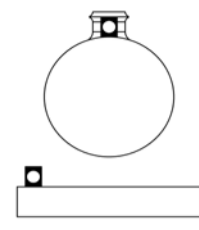
Stopping passenger, rail motor, or a breakdown train returning from a job.



Class C (3)

Express parcels, fish livestock, milk, fruit or perishables.

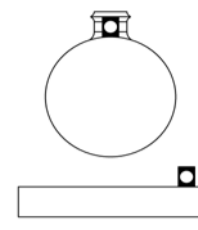
55 mph



Class D (4)

Express freight or livestock, with at least 1/3 fitted, or empty coaching stock.

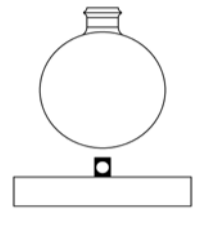
45 mph



Class E (5)

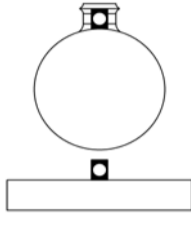
Express freight or cattle with less than 1/3 fitted wagons.

40 mph



Class G (7)

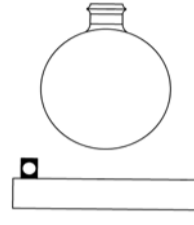
Light engine, or engine with 1 or 2 brake vans attached.



Class H (6)

Through freight or ballast train.

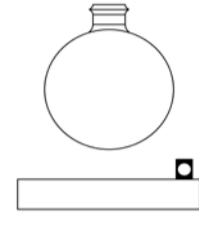
35 mph



Class J (8)

Through mineral or empty wagon train.

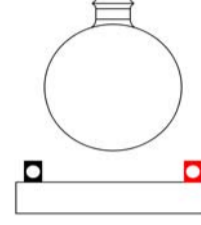
35 mph



Class K (9)

Pick up or branch freight, or mineral or ballast train on a short run.

Shunting loco. One white and one red light, red light furthest from running line.

Additionally, the following speed limits applied.
